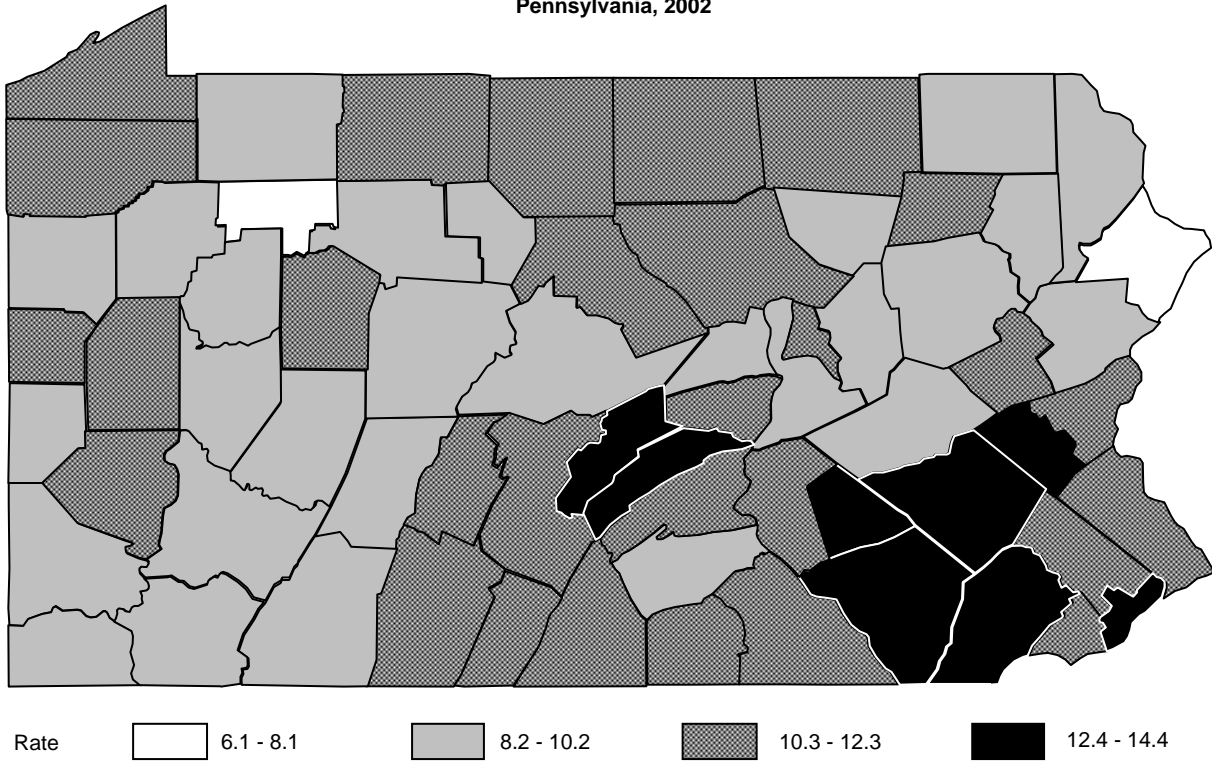

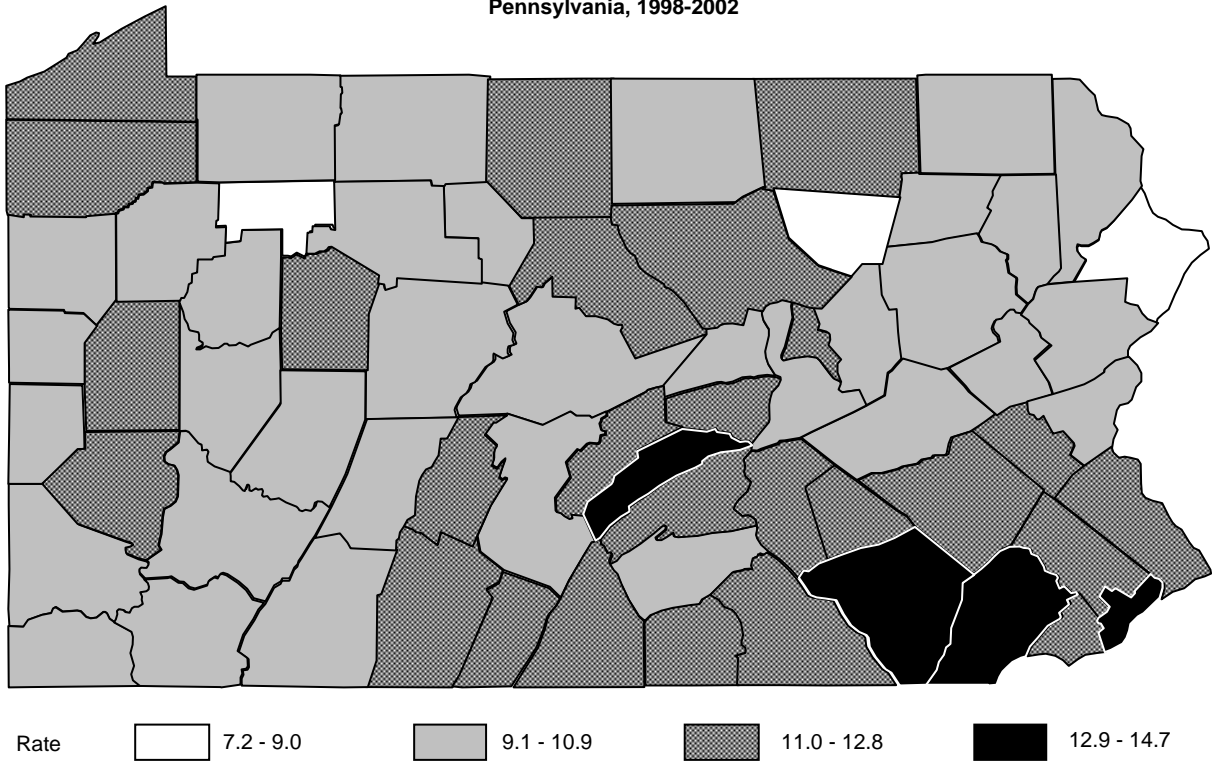

Pennsylvania, 2002



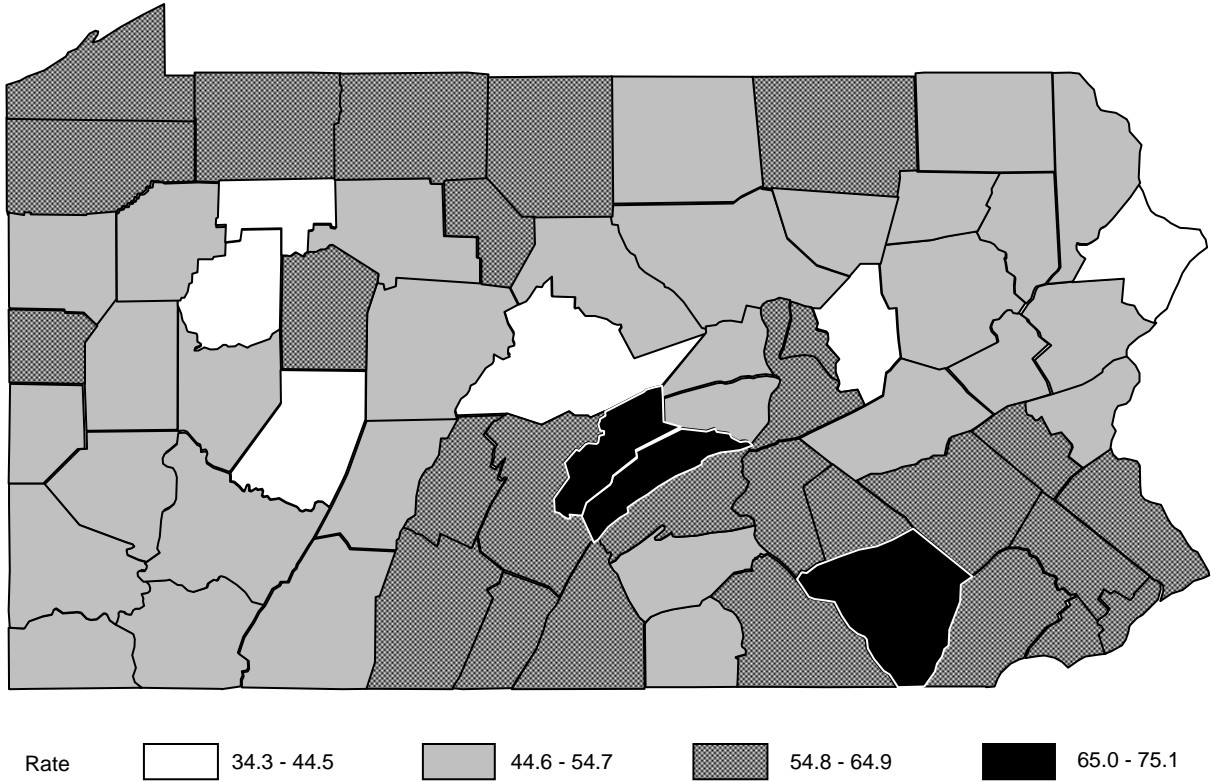
