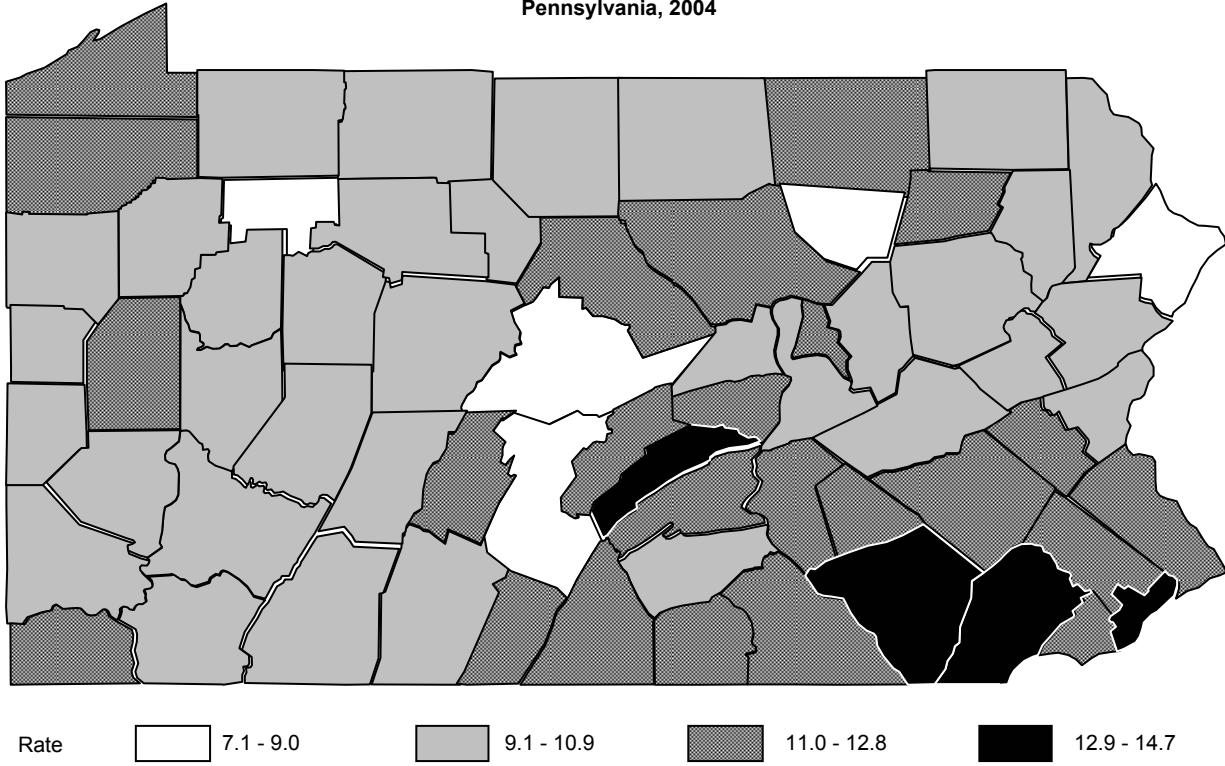

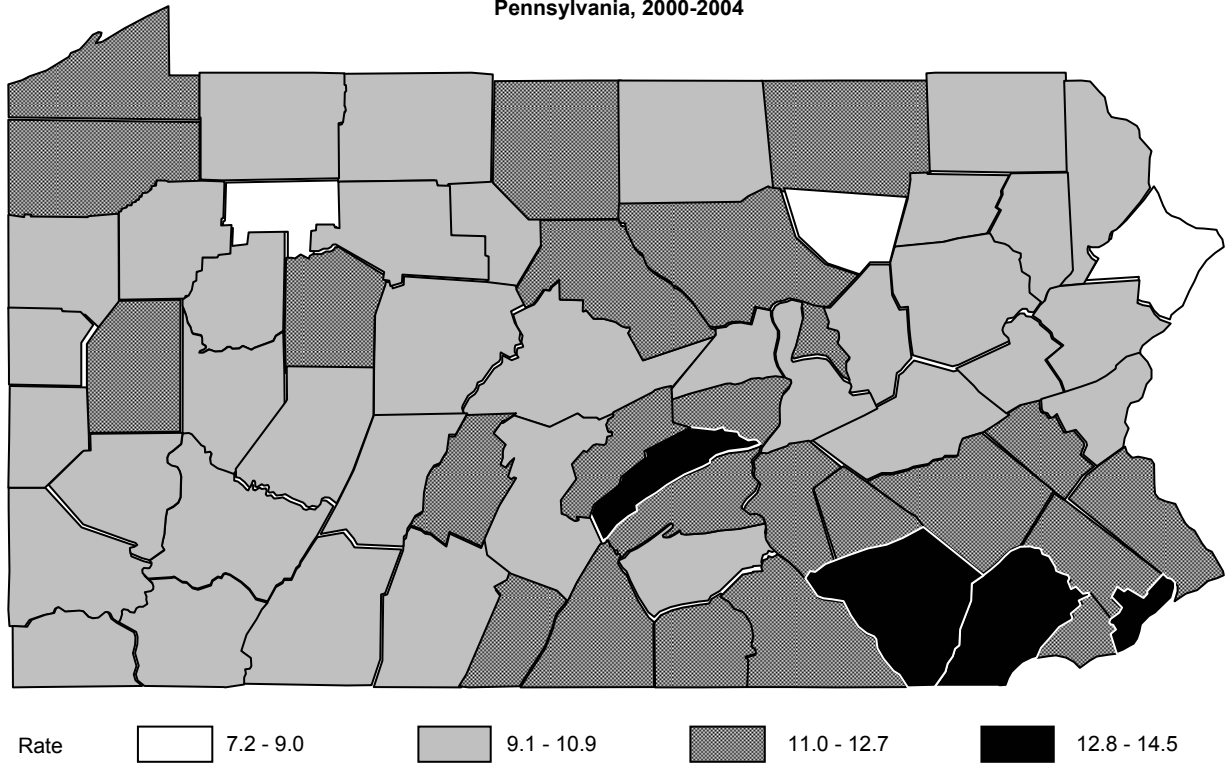

Pennsylvania, 2004



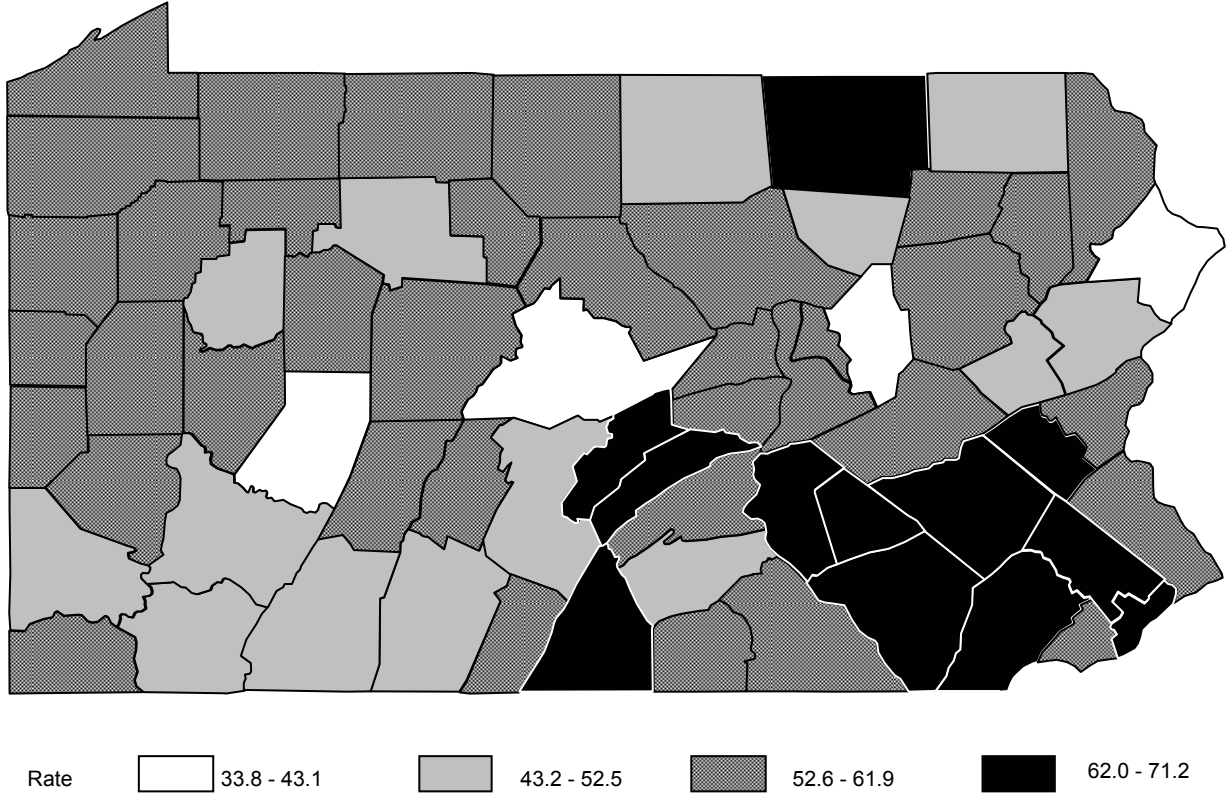
