 Pennsylvania, 2005**

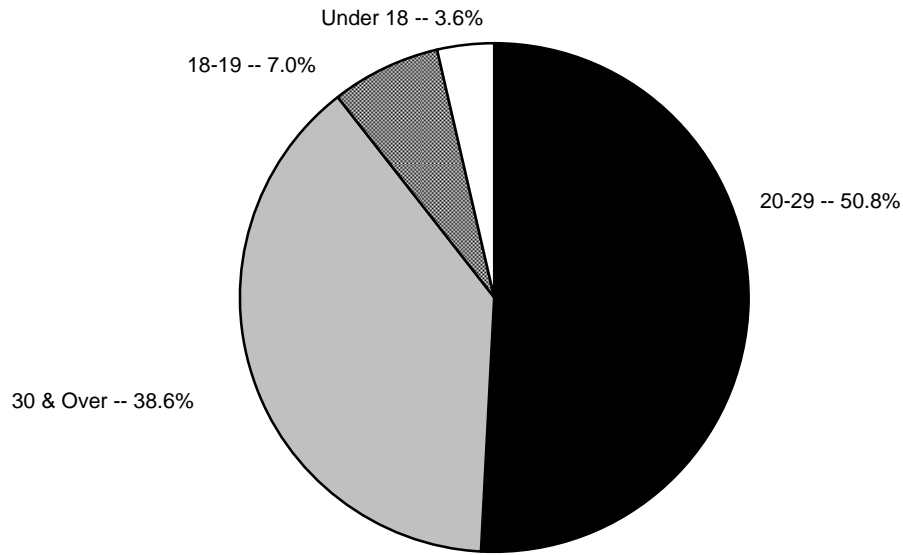
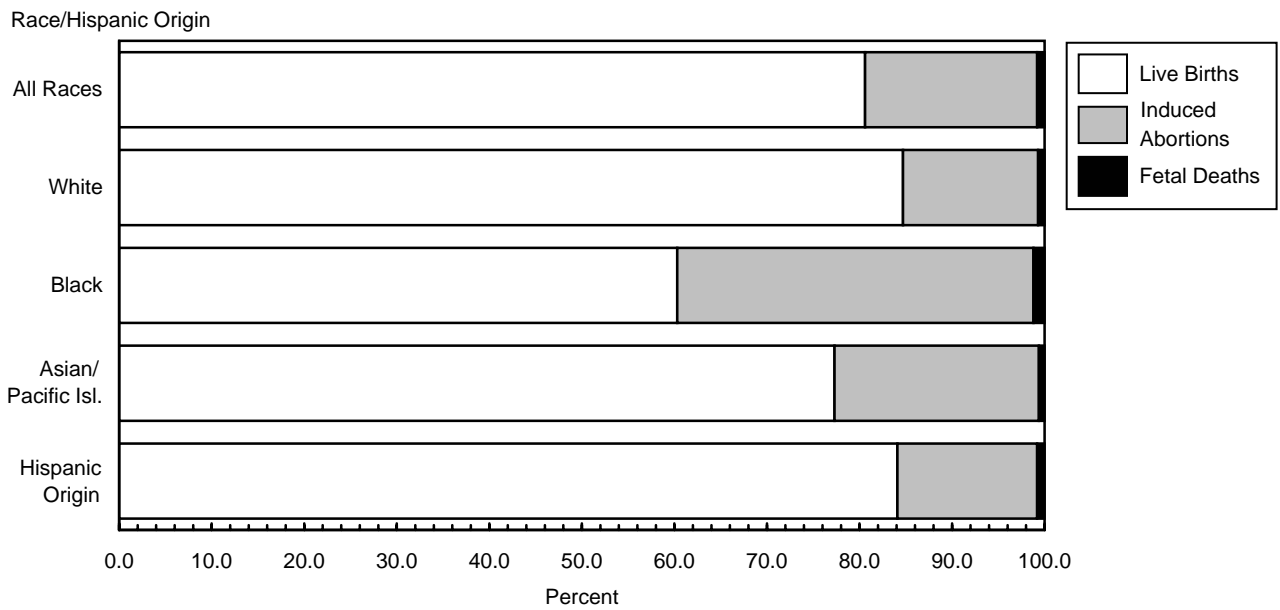
