

2007 ABORTION STATISTICS

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In 2007, there were 36,663 abortions performed in Pennsylvania. The 2007 figure is a 44.3 percent decrease from the 1980 total of 65,777 (the highest annual number ever recorded in Pennsylvania). The 2007 figure represents a decrease of 68 or 0.2 percent from the 36,731 that occurred in 2006. The lowest annual number occurred in 1999 (34,494).

Nearly all abortions in 2007 (34,301 or 93.6 percent) were performed in the first 14 weeks of pregnancy (first trimester).

Almost 55 percent (20,032) of all abortions performed in Pennsylvania were to White women and 14,462 or 39.4 percent were to Black women. Abortions to women of Hispanic origin (regardless of race) accounted for 2,254 or 6.1 percent of all abortions in 2007.

Over 86 percent or 31,609 of the abortions performed in Pennsylvania in 2007 were to unmarried women.

Patients age 19 and under accounted for 17.9 percent or 6,557 of the 2007 abortions performed in Pennsylvania. Teenagers age 17 and younger accounted for 6.3 percent or 2,296 of the 2007 abortions. The 2006 percentage was similar at 6.2. As in previous years, the largest single age group was 20-24, accounting for 12,365 or 33.7 percent of all 2007 abortions.

Of all the abortions that occurred in 2007 in Pennsylvania, 35,217 or 96.1 percent were performed on residents. The 2006 figure was similar at 95.8 percent. Residents of other states, territories and other countries accounted for 1,446 abortions in 2007, compared to 1,539 in 2006.

Of the abortion patients who resided in Pennsylvania, 13,830 or 39.3 percent were residents of Philadelphia. Other counties with a large number of resident abortions included Allegheny, 4,349; Delaware, 1,780; Montgomery, 1,714; and Bucks, 1,387. Of all 67 counties, 40 (59.7 percent) showed a decrease in the number of resident abortions performed in 2007 compared to 2006.

Of the abortions performed in 2007 in Pennsylvania, 94.4 percent occurred in seven counties - Allegheny, Bucks, Chester, Dauphin, Delaware, Lehigh, and Philadelphia.

In 2007, there were 75 reports of complications of abortions submitted by physicians, which was 10.7 percent fewer than the 84 reported in 2006. Almost 70 percent of the complications in 2007 were related to retained products of conception, 22.7 percent to bleeding, and 6.7 percent to infection.

As of December 31, 2007, there were 97 facilities in the Commonwealth registered with the Department of Health to perform abortions as required by the Abortion Control Act.

Notes: The source for the number of abortions reported in Pennsylvania in 2007 is the "Report of Induced Termination of Pregnancy" which is an individual report filed for each procedure. The source for the complications data are "Abortions: Report of Complications" - a separate reporting form completed by physicians who have provided medical care to a woman because of a complication resulting from an abortion or attempted abortion.
